**A big thank you** to all who have supported us through prayer and giving. It's been an exciting year in many ways. James, Debbie and the children have settled in well, and got stuck into what they believe God has called them to (will expand on this later). Colin continues to be a great asset to the mission base and faithfully gets out there and engages in sharing the good news. Pam and I continue to be blessed in many, many ways. Our second grand child Francesca was born late September and just like Eva her cousin, she is beautiful in so many ways.

**The Jesus Bus** continues to be a place of blessing, via the faithful witness of the local team in Ellesmere Port. We are currently only using the bus in Ellesmere Port after saying farewell to the folk in Warrington, and we are praying and discerning which other town/community should be next to engage with. The community on the bus is now mainly young adults between 17 and 21 years of age and there is a very strong and healthy relationship between all, to

such an extent I have now explored and been accepted for ordination next June. So I can when needed, do the 'Ordained' ministry within the bus community, and of course to some degree in St Thomas and St Lawrence's.. Please pray regarding this, as I really believe it to be in God's will, but I also feel that I need to be able to remain on the edge of the established church as an evangelist.

**Narrow boat Andrew** is up and running and being well used by ourselves and our partners at the boat museum, who have afforded us free training and mooring. This will be a part of an art exhibition that is being run by the community in **Trinity Methodist**, Ellesmere Port. **Debbie** who is part of **The Church Army Community** has just re-launched along with Gill our New Associate Rector, '**Messy Church**' in Christchurch C of E Primary School.; Please hold both ministries up in prayer.

**What are Pam and I up to?**

Pam is still walking her feet off as a post lady in Neston, but also playing her part as one of the team and thoroughly enjoying being a granny (lol). I continue heading up the mission base, bus, boat etc plus my role as Padre with the local sea cadets.. The latter has afforded me a great opportunity for adventure and sharing the gospel.

I have been selected to be a crew member for part of the **Round the world Clipper Race**. This October I spent three crazy weeks of intense sailing training down in Gosport, despite the stormy weather. Next March I will be flying out to China to join one of the round the world race yachts ,
